

# Board of Education Meeting

## Privilege of the Floor Sign Up

All meetings of the Board of Education shall be conducted in public, and the public has the right to attend all such meetings. Public expression at such meetings is encouraged and a specific portion of the agenda provides for members of the public to address the Board. This period of the meeting is listed on the agenda as the privilege of the floor. The purpose of allowing the public to make statements during the meeting is to allow for additional views on agenda topics to be heard and considered. This is not the time or place to register complaints about individuals or about items that have not first been addressed, through proper channels, that is, with those closest to the issue, such as a teacher, the building principal, the superintendent, or other appropriate party. Individuals making statements during privilege of the floor are expected to be courteous and respectful, modeling for our students how one can participate and have their voice heard, in situations where there is agreement or disagreement with others' views. If members of the public have gone through proper channels and still wish to discuss a personnel matter with the Board, they can submit their comments in writing to the Board President or they can request an Executive session with the Board. A period not to exceed thirty minutes is set aside for the first part of the meeting for privilege of the floor. The time may be extended by a majority vote of the Board.
